Explores past and present landscapes from the Great Plains to the Pacific coast. This is an easy-to-use map that uses historic and current aerial imagery to highlight how our landscapes have changed since the mid-20th century and how we can conserve our natural heritage. Maps go back to the 1950s.

COVER CROP CHART (experience.arcgis.com)

In 2007, researchers at the USDA-ARS Northern Great Plains Research Laboratory (NGPRL) were exploring new approaches to incorporate cover crops into dryland cropping systems. As the team began working on this exciting topic, they struggled to compile meaningful information about cover crops relevant to the challenging growing conditions of the northern Great Plains. Additionally, traditional and electronic resources at the time typically organized cover crop information alphabetically or separately in an outline format. The categorizations often emphasized a singular focus on select crops, and accordingly, fell short in highlighting potential complementary functions between cover crop types. Moreover, cover crop information at the time relied heavily on written descriptions. Visual aids were rare.
